HHP SCALING SPECIFICATIONS

SCALE IS INTERNATIONAL 1/4" RULE

ALL WOOD SHALL BE FRESH CUT FROM LIVING TREES

- All grades must meet minimum length (8' 6") and Maximum length (16' 6") requirements
- All lengths to be cut in multiples of 2'
- Pallet logs must be sound and straight. 8" & 9" logs must have 1 clear face
- Defects with 8" of the log end are not considered a defect in logs 10' or longer
- All grades, other than Pallet, must meet minimum (10") and Maximum (36") diameter requirements
- Trim allowance must be a minimum of 6"
- A single, straight seam is not considered a defect in saw logs other than Beech and White Birch
- Logs containing iron will be culled

Deductions in scale will be made for:

- Rot
- Holes
- Cracks
- Sweep
- Splits
- Spider
- Fiber Pull
- Shake
- Knots
- Crook
- Seams
- Being Mis-bucked
- Insect Damage

Any sawlog *NOT* meeting the above specifications will be paid at the current firewood rate *ONLY* if it meets current pulpwood specifications. All others will be culled

PULP DELIVERIES Effective 4/22/10 FOB Henniker

Hardwood, Hemlock, Aspen and Pine Pulp

Pulpwood will be purchased only from *Certified Timber Harvesters* meeting HHP, Inc. Procurement Policy Guidelines.

Our Procurement department must *approve all pulp deliveries in advance.*

All pulp *must* meet the following specifications:

Hemlock, Pine & Hardwood (ALL SPECIES)

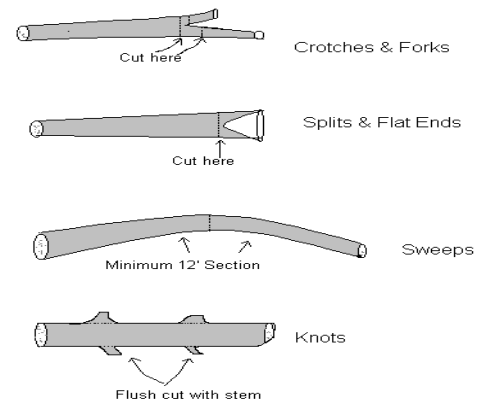
- Minimum diameter- 5" Aspen 4"
- Maximum diameter – 24" Aspen 20"
- Minimum length- 12'
- Ring de-barker quality
- Fresh cut from living trees
- Aspen – 3" Rim sound wood

Pulp *NOT* meeting the above Criteria is subject to rejection

Pulp meeting the above criteria will be paid at the rates of:

Hardwood: \$30/Ton
Pine: \$21 /Ton

Hemlock: \$30/Ton
Aspen \$34/Ton
